Isn't it true that despite all the time, effort, and resources we invest in living a meaningful life on earth, our ultimate goal is to be with God in eternity? How do we maintain an eternal glance while we live this temporal life? Jesus has the answer. No! Jesus IS the answer.

Lenten Series 2025 (six Fridays of Lent) will propose Jesus as the "contemplative par excellence" who also led an active life. 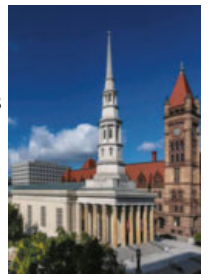
**Save the date: Ladies Lent Retreat**

On March 19, we celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of Mary. St. Joseph dedicated his life to the care of the Blessed Virgin and Jesus. To honor him, there is a classic Catholic tradition we know as St. Joseph's Table where food is set aside for the poor.



In honor of St. Joseph, you are invited to bring non-perishable food items to the church from March 11 – 18. We will bless all the donations during the evening prayer scheduled in his honor on March 18 (the evening prayer service is being held on this date due to other obligations on March 19). Your donations will benefit the St. Vincent De Paul Food Pantry and the "Feed the Spirit" ministry to assist children in need that attend our school.

Please place your donation by the statue of St. Joseph in the Holy Family Chapel. If you bring them during the week and the church is not open, please take it to the church office.

While we will accept and be thankful for all food donations, we are targeting this year's collection to some of the most needed items in the food pantry.

These items are as follows:

- Soups of all types
- Canned fruit
- Canned Chili/Beef stew
- Canned Ravioli
- Canned spaghetti
- Canned meats (tuna, chicken breast etc)
- Breakfast cereal & meatballs
- Jelly
- Spaghetti sauce

The 'Feed the Spirit' ministry is in need of the below items.

- Breakfast foods in individual bags or containers (oatmeal, cream of wheat, breakfast bars, pop tarts, cereal cups)
