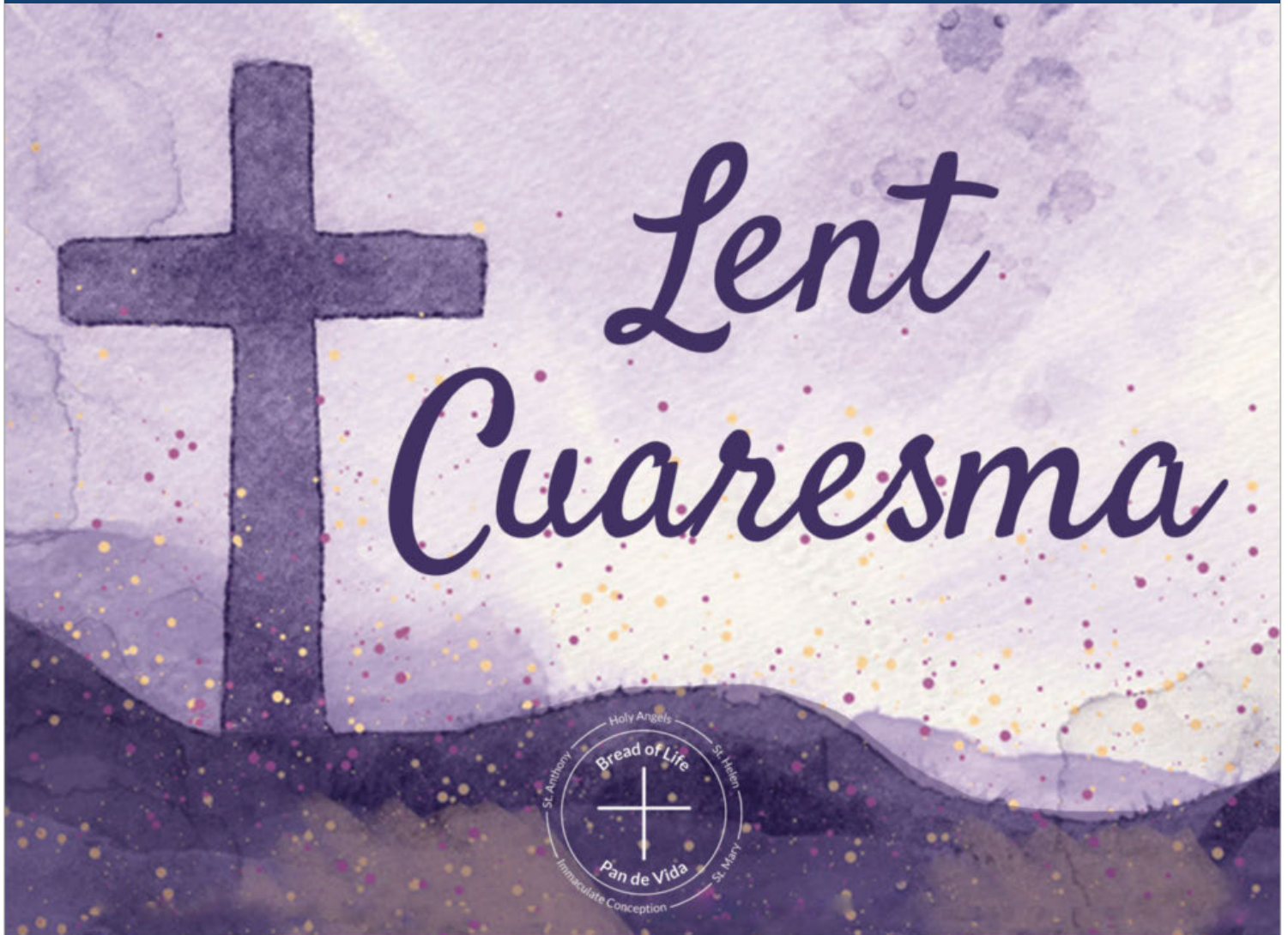

On March 19, we celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of Mary. St. Joseph dedicated his life to the care of the Blessed Virgin and Jesus. To honor him, there is a classic Catholic tradition we know as St. Joseph's Table where food is set aside for the poor.



In honor of St. Joseph, you are invited to bring non-perishable food items to the church from March 11 – 18. 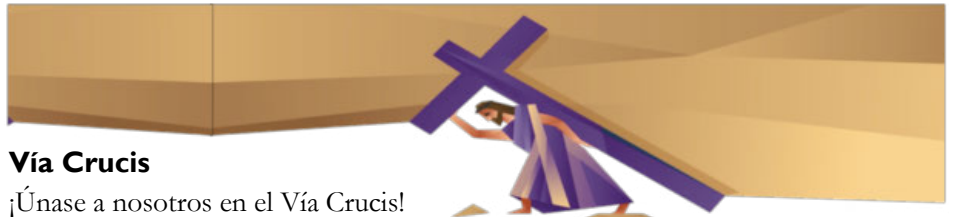
