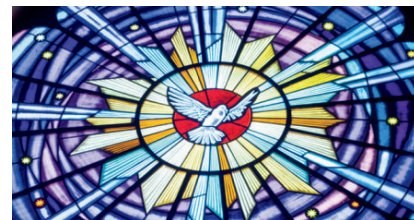

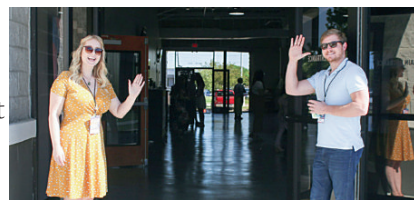

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd: September Spotlight

This month, we highlight a parent's joyful experience with the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) program. Matthew Irwin, a member of the CGSUSA Board of Trustees, shares examples of how each of his children encountered the living God in the atrium (the prepared environment).*



Transformed!

"My wife, Camila, and I have been completely transformed by the experience of raising our six children in the atrium, and we are in awe of all we have seen grow within them."

"The little boy who wondered so long and hard about the history of the kingdom of God in the atrium, now hikes America and asks the deepest questions about life."

"The little boy who used to copy scripture before he could read and write, now wakes the dawn with his Bible and breviary."

"The little girl who wondered so long and hard about the beloved sheep of the Good Shepherd, and one day emphatically declared, 'It's us! I've been knowing this since I was a baby!'"

"And our extra special baby boy, who stared transfixed whenever we sang to him as a baby, is now a big boy who makes the sign of the cross, makes the signs during prayer songs with Papi, and runs laughing to the sanctuary steps during Mass!"

Set free!

"Camila and I have been set free from the expectation to be master teachers and instead have become parents who live and share our relationship with Jesus alongside our children. What began as our gratitude to Sofia, Gianna, and Maria [founders of the CGS and Montessori programs] – and above all to God (el Niño Dios) – for showing us a way to raise our children has grown steadily over the years into an awareness that the history of the Kingdom of God is a history of friendship."

LETTER FROM THE BISHOPS OF OHIO

August 27, 2025

Dear brothers and sisters who have sought refuge in Ohio,

We, the Bishops of Ohio, offer you the peace of Christ, a peace that surpasses worldly understanding. That same peace which Pope Leo XIV announced during his first appearance to the world as successor of St. Peter, "... the peace of the risen Christ. A peace that is unarmed and disarming, humble and persevering. A peace that comes from God, the God who loves us all, unconditionally."

Many of you face significant hurdles to experiencing peace due to precarious circumstances in your countries of origin and an uncertain future in Ohio, despite your efforts to navigate the complex and rapidly changing immigration processes to obtain legal status. Our brother bishops in your home countries continually express the need for humanitarian relief from the conditions that forced you to flee in the first place, including Haiti, Cuba, Nicaragua, Venezuela, Cameroon, Ukraine, and other areas of the world.

It pains us to hear that our brothers and sisters, even those with lawful immigration status, live in fear of going to work, worshiping at the local parish, or participating in community events. Daily routines now needlessly bring angst of the unknown and the threat of being detained. Additionally, long-term visa and green card holders have faced forced departure without due consideration for their circumstances. We regret that our nation's immigration system has failed to offer predictability and stability to those living as law-abiding residents and supporting themselves and their families.

As we visit parishes and communities across Ohio, your priests, friends, employers, and some public officials share that you are valued community members. Your work strengthens society, and your prayers and service build up the body of Christ. We thank you for your contributions to our parishes and the common good of Ohio through your faith, work ethic, and cultural enrichment of our communities. We also thank those who have welcomed and accompanied you.

St. Paul tells us in 1 Corinthians, chapter 12, "there are many parts, yet one body... if [one] part suffers, all the parts suffer with it." The possibility that you may be forced to return to your home countries while perilous conditions persist there deeply grieves us. As you suffer in this uncertainty, our communities and the Church suffer with you.

In reflecting on the parable of the Good Samaritan, Pope Leo XIV recently shared, "God has looked upon us with compassion; he wanted to walk our same path and come down among us. In Jesus, the Good Samaritan, he came to heal our wounds and to pour out upon us the balm of his love and mercy." We pray that the same compassion that moved the heart of the Father and now moves us may also motivate policymakers to recognize your circumstances and contributions to society and establish reasonable pathways for you and your loved ones to fully integrate as Ohioans.

Please know of our spiritual closeness to you and your pastors as they accompany you in navigating uncertainty. May our parishes continue to be a refuge from your sorrows, where the faithful welcome you in your time of need. Hold onto the peace of the risen Christ and let us all bear witness to the unity and reconciliation found in the Gospel, remembering that we are all one in Christ Jesus (Galatians 3:28).

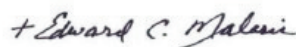

CARTA DE LOS OBISPOS DE OHIO

27 de agosto de 2025



Queridos hermanos y hermanas que han buscado refugio en Ohio, Nosotros, los obispos de Ohio, les ofrecemos la paz de Cristo, una paz que supera el entendimiento de este mundo. Esa misma paz que el Papa León XIV anunció durante su primer saludo al mundo como sucesor de San Pedro, "... la paz de Cristo resucitado, una paz desarmada y una paz desarmante, humilde y perseverante. Proviene de Dios, Dios que nos

ama a todos incondicionalmente".

Muchos de ustedes enfrentan obstáculos significativos para experimentar la paz debido a circunstancias precarias

en sus países de origen y un futuro incierto en Ohio, a pesar de sus esfuerzos por navegar los procesos de inmigración

complejos y rápidamente cambiantes para obtener estatus legal. Nuestros hermanos obispos en sus países de origen

expresan continuamente la necesidad de ayuda humanitaria por las condiciones que los obligaron a ustedes a huir en primer

lugar, incluyendo Haití, Cuba, Nicaragua, Venezuela, Camerún, Ucrania y otras áreas del mundo.

Nos duele escuchar que nuestros hermanos y hermanas, incluso aquellos con estatus migratorio

legal, viven con miedo de ir a trabajar, asistir a la parroquia local o participar en eventos comunitarios. Las rutinas

cotidianas ahora traen consigo innecesariamente la angustia de lo desconocido y la amenaza de ser detenidos. Además,

personas con visas de largo plazo y residencia permanente se han enfrentado a una salida forzada sin la debida

consideración de sus circunstancias. Lamentamos que el sistema de inmigración de nuestra nación no haya podido ofrecer

previabilidad y estabilidad a quienes viven como residentes respetuosos de la ley y se sostienen a sí mismos y a sus familias.

Mientras visitamos parroquias y comunidades en todo Ohio, sus sacerdotes, amigos, empleadores y algunos

funcionarios públicos comparten que ustedes son miembros valiosos de la comunidad. Su trabajo fortalece a la sociedad

y sus oraciones y servicio edifican el cuerpo de Cristo. Les agradecemos sus contribuciones a nuestras parroquias y al

bien común de Ohio a través de su fe, ética de trabajo y enriquecimiento cultural de nuestras comunidades. Agradecemos

también a quienes los han acogido y acompañado.

San Pablo nos dice en 1 Corintios, capítulo 12, "el cuerpo tiene muchos miembros, y sin embargo, es uno, ... ¿Un

samaritano, ha venido a sanar nuestras heridas, derramando sobre nosotros el aceite de su amor y de su misericordia".

Otramos para que la misma compasión que conmovió el corazón del Padre y ahora nos conmueve a nosotros también,

motive a los responsables políticos a reconocer las circunstancias y contribuciones de ustedes a la sociedad y establecer
