

# Bible Study: From the Wood of the Crib to the Wood of the Cross (Chapters 2 from Matthew and Luke

Wednesdays November 5, 12, 19 & December 3, 10 in IC's Chapel 7:00-8:30 pm

For those seeking a fuller experience of the coming Advent & Christmas seasons, we explore the deeper meaning of the infancy narratives which encapsulate the entire gospel in miniature. Our aim is to move beyond the sentimental aspects of Christmas to reveal the vulnerability of the child in the manger, foreshadowing the suffering and sacrifice of the adult Christ: from the wood of the crib to the wood of the cross, from the swaddling clothes of Bethlehem to the burial cloths of Golgotha. Join us as we venture past the "baby Jesus" and embrace the more challenging call for a mature, adult response to the Gospel.



After returning to the US, she received a master's degree in Theology and Pastoral Ministry from Villanova University. She spent six years working as executive director at Augustinian Defenders of the Rights of the Poor, an immigrant serving nonprofit in Philadelphia, PA. Last year, she and her family moved to Dayton and joined Immaculate Conception Church. Lacie began working at ABLE Law last November as a community organizer for the Agricultural Workers and Immigrants Rights practice. She enjoys running, knitting, and spending time with her family.

### **Kurt Horner**

My name is Kurt Horner. My wife Elizabeth and I live and Dayton. We have two daughters, both of whom attended Holy Angels School and are now out in the world. I have been a member of Holy Angels parish for some 25 years.

I jumped into mission work when I joined the Holy Angels Twining Committee in 2012 as we formalized our Twinning relationship with Paroisse Rwaza in the nation of Rwanda in East Africa. My first trip to Rwanda was in 2017 with a small group of Twinning Committee members. I was 51 years old at the time, and that was my first mission trip. "You're never too old..." as the saying goes.

I have returned to Paroisse Rwaza every year since 2017, save 2020 when COVID had other plans for us all. I return to Rwaza both to be present with our Twinning partners and to represent the parishioners of Holy Angels. The generosity of Holy Angels parishioners allows our Twinning efforts to focus on access to a Catholic education for vulnerable young women of Rwaza. We are connected to three education institutions: a Technical & Vocational Education & Training (TVET) school, a day school, and a nationally recognized women's boarding school. Our Twinning work makes possible a Catholic education for some twenty young women at Rwaza.

I bring the experience with the Rwanda people home with me as I teach Employment Readiness classes as a volunteer at Catholic Social Services of the Miami Valley (CSSMV). I am a member of the Advisory Board to the Mission Office of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, working to ensure the mission of the Church continues to reach around the globe.




