## LENT

**Lenten Discipleship Challenge****Week Five: March 22-27**

The next six days, just prior to Holy Week, puts the emphasis on life over death and, as always at this point in the season, we join Jesus, Mary & Martha, the disciples, and the crowds at that forlorn cemetery at the outskirts of Bethany. The dialogue of John 11 is familiar and has been so within Christian communities for two millennia: “Our friend Lazarus is sleeping.” “Roll away the stone!” “Lazarus! Come forth!” “Unbind him and let him go free.” With such readily recognizable, powerful, and well-worn words we move from the first part of John’s Gospel, “the Book of Signs,” (John 1-12) to its climax, “the Book of Glory” (John 13-21). The following reflections were composed by parishioners within our Bread of Life/ Pan de Vida Family of Parishes. Each offers practical action steps to carry the message of each day forward.

**March 22, Fifth Sunday of Lent**

*Ezekiel 7:12-14; Romans 8:8-11; John 11:1-45*

The focus on the Fifth Sunday of Lent is resurrection and new life. Jeremiah’s ancient prophecy, “I will open your graves and have you rise from them” (Jeremiah 37:12) is literally fulfilled when in the Gospel reading Lazarus’ tomb is opened and Jesus raises him to life. This brings Mary, Martha, and others gathered at the tomb to the confession that Jesus is indeed the resurrection and life. Today, think of one person you loved deeply who has passed from this world. Thanks be to Jesus Christ, this person is with God. Whisper a prayer of gratitude to Jesus Christ.

**Monday, March 23**

*Daniel 13:1-9, 15-17, 19-30, 33-62; John 8:1-11*

Today we hear of two women accused of infidelity. In Susanna’s case, Daniel, guided by the LORD’s wisdom, catches the accusers in a lie and she is set free. Daniel brings about justice for Susanna. Jesus stops those preparing to stone the unnamed adulteress, challenging those without sin to cast the first stone (John 8:7). Jesus brings mercy for her. The church grouping these readings together creates a clear juxtaposition from the old law to the new - from justice to mercy. Recognizing that we are all sinners, Jesus teaches to act with empathy and compassion. Spend time in prayer asking the LORD to help identify a person or situation that might be approached as Jesus would.

**Tuesday, March 24**

*Numbers 21:4-9; John 8:21-30*

First century Jews knew the image of the staff of Moses as a symbol of healing. Our reading today from Numbers (21:4-9) records its most dramatic example. “If anyone is bitten and looks at the serpent mounted on a pole shall live” (21:4)! So it has been and continues to be the same regarding the pole (cross) of Christ. Catholics & Orthodox never tire of displaying images of Christ crucified in our homes and churches. Sometimes we need to “lift up” and “gaze upon” the transformative image just as the Israelites first did in the desert. Take time alone with a crucifix today and gaze upon it. Ask God to reveal it to you as “love beyond all telling.”

**Wednesday, March 25 Solemnity of the Annunciation of the LORD**

*Isaiah 7:10-14, 8:10; Hebrews 10:4-10; Luke 1:26-38*

On today’s solemnity, the readings reveal God as the giver/initiator of life. Isaiah prophesied the coming of Jesus as a sign of God’s faithful and enduring presence; Hebrews shows Christ embracing the Father’s will to bring life; and the Gospel centers on Mary’s courageous “yes,” through which Life himself takes flesh to reveal who God is and to bring salvation. Together, these readings teach that true life comes from trusting God enough to let his plans take root within. Life in Christ is neither earned or self-made, but rather a gift that is to be received, nurtured, and offered back in loving obedience. Today, practice a simple intentional “yes,” perhaps by serving another quietly, or reciting the Angelus, letting that small act make room for Christ’s life within.

**Thursday, March 26**

*Genesis 17:3-9; John 8:51-59*

The covenant between God and Abraham is relational, “God said to Abraham: On your part, you and your descendants must keep my covenant throughout the ages” (Genesis 17:9). This covenant is renewed in Christ, “... whoever keeps my word will never see death” (John 8:51). Through his Paschal Mystery, Jesus promises eternal

life. Like some of the Jews in John's gospel, we may struggle to believe he is the Word made flesh, despite the strong words in John, "Amen, amen, I say to you, before Abraham came to be I AM" (John 8:58). To struggle is to grow. As we approach Holy Week, how far have you come? Open your heart, mind and soul to a deeper relationship with our Savior. And if you have not been steadfast this Lent there is no time like the present because the Week of Weeks is about to dawn on us.

### Friday, March 27

*Jeremiah 20:10-13; John 10:31-42*

Today the prophet Jeremiah faces persecution, but his trust in God's protection prevails. In John, Jewish leaders try to stone Jesus for claiming to be the Son of God. Jesus continues to do the work of the Father, and as a result, many come to believe. When we trust God in the face of threat or fear, we breathe life into our faith. Spend a moment today mindful of your own breath: inhale the trust that God is with you, and exhale the fear that binds you. As you slowly inhale and exhale through your mouth, hear the name of God inhaling and exhaling in your breath, YAH - WEH!

### Saturday, March 28

*Ezekiel 37:21-28; John 11:45-56*

"Can you not see that it is better for one man to die, then to have the whole nation perish?" (John 11:49-50) Scholars contend that these words of Caiaphas are as historical as anything in the Gospels. The religious authorities reported potential trouble makers to the civic authorities at Passover. They'd had their eye on Jesus for some time now and the rumors of raising Lazarus was the lighting of a match in a powder keg. A revolutionary, Jesus must die. The Sanhedrin believed they were simply doing good police work to keep the nation safe in the face of potential disaster, knowing full well what Rome was capable of if there was a rebellion or a riot. Are we so unlike them? Does the end ever justify the means? Let us approach Holy Week with these questions in mind.

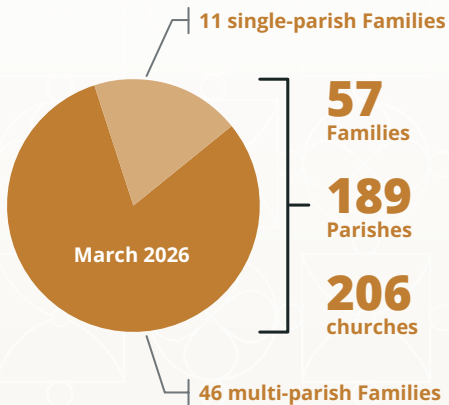
