Welcome Fr. Ron Combs!

Hi, everyone! My name is Father Ronald Patrick Combs. I am the new Parochial Vicar of the Bread of Life/Pan de Vida Family of Parishes. Catholic folks call me Father Ron.

I'm the youngest of six children, all of whom are still living and still in touch with each other. Our parents are deceased, and every now and then I might bring some of their wisdom into a homily.

My favorite holy people (besides Jesus, Mary, and Joseph) are St. Patrick, St. Monica, St. Maria Goretti, Blessed Solanus Casey, and the prophet Jeremiah. Oh, and one more: an ancestor—an English priest—on my mother's side who would not renounce his Catholicism to the King of England in the 1580s. He was martyred—hanged, drawn, and quartered—in a public square. We're not certain of his name (what with the destruction of Catholic birth records and all), but I have a few ideas of who this unnamed priest-martyr might be.

I grew up in Springdale, a Cincinnati suburb about 15 miles north of the city. I attended St. Gabriel School in Glendale (class of 1978) before moving on to Roger Bacon High School in St. Bernard (class of 1982). I attended Kentucky Wesleyan College from 1982-85 and graduated from the University of Cincinnati in 1987.

I entered seminary in 1996 and was ordained to the Priesthood of Jesus Christ in 2003. I fell in love with Dayton when I volunteered at the St. Vincent Hotel shelter (then on Fifth Street, downtown) during the academic summers of 1999 and 2001. Most of my first eighteen years of ordained ministry (2003-2021) were spent in the Dayton suburbs—Ascension for three years, and then St. Henry for most of the next fifteen years. Some of my time at St. Henry was split with assisting at Our Lady of Good Hope.

From 2021 until now, I have been a hospital chaplain at two very large hospitals in Cincinnati. I've been told that I have pastoral gifts for hospital chaplaincy, as well as possessing ministerial gifts in end-of-life care and preaching at funerals. However, I've been discerning a return to parish ministry for some time. The fact that I'm returning to Dayton is a bonus!

I'm an adopted member of the Flyer Faithful. I'm also a fan of all the Cincinnati professional sports teams (Reds, Bengals, and FC), the Dayton Dragons, and the NHL's Washington Capitals. Hobbies include traveling (the Mid-Atlantic beaches are my favorite spot). I also paint from time to time. However, you won't catch me painting bowls of fruit; rather, I try to put dilemmas, emotions, and feelings onto canvas. I hope to set up a little studio space in my new residence here in the Bread of Life/Pan de Vida parish family.

Oh, I almost forgot. I also like dogs. A lot. But I won't be bringing one with me to Dayton, so I guess I'll have to get my "dog fix" from parishioners and staff!

Well, I guess that's it. I look forward to meeting you and growing the Kingdom together.
