SafeParish Training

The Safe Environment Office of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati continually reviews its procedures to ensure the highest standards of child protection. As part of these ongoing efforts, and in alignment with U.S.C.C.B. recommendations, we are expanding our background check protocols.

In addition to the ongoing quarterly updates from the SELECTION.com database, all electronic background checks will now require renewal every five years.

Any individual who is SafeParish trained and has a background check older than five years will need to renew their background check.

In the coming weeks/months, these individuals will receive an email from SafeParish with detailed instructions on how to complete the renewal process. Please check Spam or Junk folders if you do not receive an email from SafeParish and your electronic background check was completed more than five years ago.

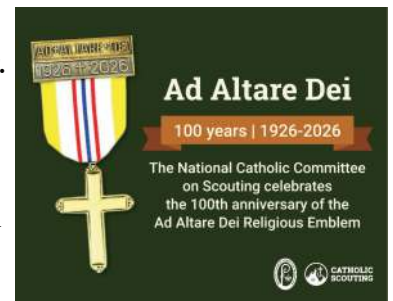

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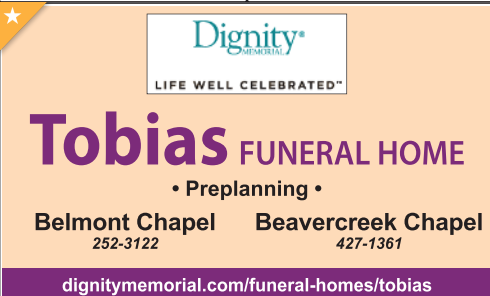
